Public Outreach

Hello NYN Family,

A question came from another Area about fees for having a table for outreach for a professional conferences. They were asked to donate a gift card or cash for a raffle or door prize. If that was required to participate, WSO would speak to the event sponsor as to why that is not in keeping with our principles of Al-Anon's primary purpose or the principle of attraction in our public relations policy. Al-Anon literature is an acceptable contribution in keeping with the Traditions. It carries information about our program.

If you go to the WSO website, alanon.org, select Members and Public Outreach. There are many suggestions on how to reach out. You can watch the two newest PSAs, find posters to use and how to add local information, print a form if a local station wants to receive a PSA, and media questions and answers that may be used for an interview.

There is so much information available on the site and it is being updated often. Keep an eye out for new posters. Don't forget <u>Al-</u> <u>Anon Faces Alcoholism</u> is now available in unlimited amounts. It can be ordered at any time from your local Literature Distribution Center or online at AFG, Inc.

JOY is our topic. Just Open Yourself! This Fall is our Election Assembly. Consider stepping up to a position and find the joy of learning about your abilities and stepping into another layer of service. 
