Stepping up is our topic, and I chose it because it doesn't seem popular, but was essential for my recovery.

At our local Al-Anon Information Service meetings, part of the opening statement was; "Service is onethird of recovery." For me, it was more like onehalf. I discovered early on the benefit of taking risks, which I had avoided for most of my life, because I was always projecting the outcome, and because I had low self-esteem, it was usually rejection I expected. I finally started taking a risk during my second year in Al-Anon, asking members if they would share at our meeting. It was hard for me to do, but the expected "no" didn't happen, and every week when I asked someone, I felt better about myself, and it felt like a miracle happening. It was the turning point for my life. Since then, I have taken many risks in Al-Anon, and my personal life, because I know the benefit I've received.

It is now almost automatic that I take risks, including standing for Delegate when no one else seemed to want it. Looking back, I'm grateful that Molly C. also stood up, and that she is our Delegate for Panel 58. It was never in my thoughts to be Delegate, but my life is so much better than it would be if I hadn't taken risks and gotten involved. There was a time when I was afraid to chair a meeting. I feel good being able to take on new tasks that in the past seemed impossible.

If you are sponsoring someone, I hope you encourage them to step up to service. When I was a newcomer, I was told that when asked to do service, you didn't say "no," especially when asked to share. My experience is that those who get involved in service are the ones with the best recovery.

Speaking personally, I still expect to benefit from service in the future. Being human to me means mistakes are expected, but so is growth through service.
