## Public Outreach Report for the AWSC meeting, April 2, 2016- NYN, Area 39

- 1. April is alcohol awareness month. Many of us have asked our libraries if we could set up a display using our Al-Anon literature and our outreach materials. Let me know what you are doing in your community.
- 2. Several events have taken place in Rochester. Brian O., our public outreach committee chair for Rochester AIS, along with other Al-Anon members, did a presentation for 30 professionals at a treatment center. Brian brought his daily readers and mentioned that our literature can be ordered online. The audience seemed genuinely interested. Our members answered many questions about what Al-Anon is and is not. Another event took place at a Health Center where approximately 125 people were in attendance. Outreach materials were made available. Brian sent thank you notes to both the treatment and health centers.
- 3. Carla, our public outreach committee chair for Syracuse AIS, told me about a meeting with the Director and a counselor from a Syracuse Health Center. Literature was provided to them and they are looking into having a member from Al-Anon speak to the families they serve.
- 4. Materials for educators and professionals, and more general information about Al-Anon and Alateen, were presented at a Community Forum on Substance Abuse back in January in Syracuse as well as in the Finger Lakes area back in February.
- Carla, will be leaving us the beginning of April and moving to Yellow Stone National Park.
   I will miss working with Carla and I know the people in Syracuse will miss her as well.
   Thank you Carla for carrying the message of Al-Anon in the Syracuse area.
