#### Periodically this year we will feature a section on "Service"

"Service is how I

practice my program."

My recovery in Al-Anon ... has been a bit like learning tennis. For a while you can just read the books and learn the theory while you sit in the bleachers and watch the game. But you won't really learn tennis until you get out of your seat and onto the court and start hitting the ball. And you only get better with practice.

Service is the part of my program where I get out of my seat and put Al-Anon into action. *It's how I practice my program.* 

My first step into service was putting away the group's literature after the meeting and two things came from that small act. I became more familiar with the literature (I could even answer questions about it) and I went from attendee to member. I started to feel like I was part of something and that I belonged. I then took the bold step of committing to share on a

topic in my home group. I was nervous and didn't feel qualified. I went to the literature and read everything I could on that topic and then shared what I had learned, and I had learned so much! Eventually I summoned the courage to chair a meeting and then I stepped up to

serve as Group Representative.

Service gives me the opportunity to put what I hear at the meetings into practice. It takes me from

passive recipient to active participant; from waiting for good things to happen to making good things happen myself; from feeling powerless, to engaging with my higher power. I'm still learning and growing through this program one step at a time. My service work isn't always easy but it is always awesome!!!
