Dear NYN Friends,

NYN Alateen business has been pretty quiet this summer.

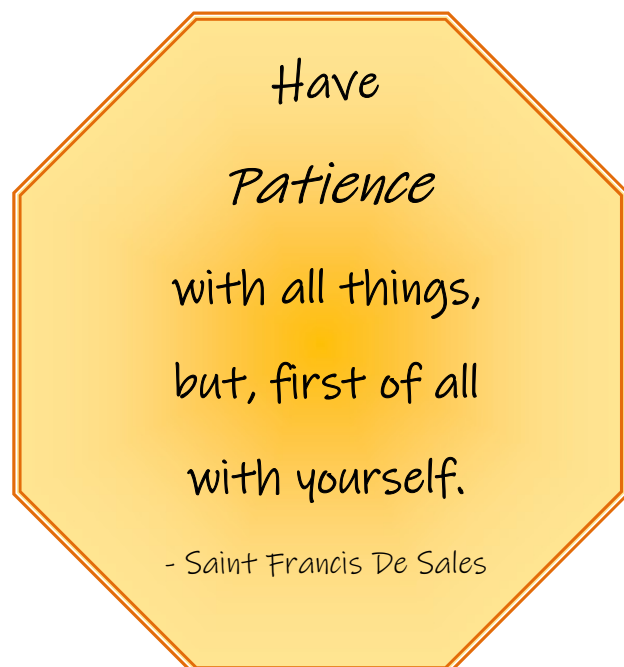

## **NYNAC Coordinator**

I would like to thank the groups and individual Al-Anon members for all the support they have shown for NYNAC as a whole. After a review of the policies and guidelines, I have found that fundraising by the NYNAC coordinator is not part of their job duties. Any future donations and contributions sent to the NYNAC coordinator will be returned to the sender(s).

This does not mean that Al-Anon members may not support Alateens and NYNAC. The teens and Alateen groups are encouraged to do fund-raising so that they can defray their costs to attend NYNAC. The individual's cost to attend NYNAC is based on the cost of the facility, meals, insurance and incidentals. This figure is then divided by the number of people attending. It appears for the 2018 NYNAC the individual cost will be \$130.00-\$135.00.

Alateen groups may conduct their own fund-raisers such as spaghetti suppers, pancake breakfasts, ice cream socials or even a bake sale (they are encouraged to do so). Members supporting these activities are supporting NYNAC. Individuals, groups or districts may wish to support Alateens by sending donations to individual Alateen groups in their district. If there is no Alateen group in your district you may chose to support an Alateen group that is close to you.

Again, I want to say thank you for all the support NYN has given to NYNAC, I hope that you will continue to do so.

Thanks to the recovery people around me, I was able to see the insanity of that. I had to be patient. I was unemployed for almost a year and used that time to grow in my recovery. (HP does for me, what I cannot do for myself). I finally

did get a job offer in wonderful Albany, NY. Because I was patient and waited for HP to show me the right path, I did a geographical, but at HP's direction, not mine. The move was the best thing for my recovery. I found a new family here and living pretty close to happy, joyous and free. I am writing this while at the 2018 Al-Anon International Convention, where I will be moderating a panel. Two things I could never have imagined a few years ago. All because I waited for HP to show me his will and I did not follow mine.
