## A Warm Fall Weekend in Fayetteville, NY!

*I'm so grateful* to everyone who participated in the September 16-17 Fall Assembly in Fayetteville, NY, with a special shout out to the Assembly Committee & Technical Team, who put it all together quickly. Participants' feedback is welcome (email: [chairperson@nynafg.com](mailto:chairperson@nynafg.com)).

*Special Guest "Virtual" Presentation:* on the "Global Electronic Area" (GEA), by Vali F., WSO Executive Director. We learned that NYN needs to decide if we will accept electronic groups in our Area service structure. A work group was formed.

*Budget:* Every fall we review & approve the budget. We increased the equipment line item from \$500/yr to \$1500/yr (for sufficient funds to purchase technical equipment for future hybrid meetings). We authorized the officers & coordinators to approve equipment purchases. We approved a \$5000 donation to WSO, & we made changes to the Treasurer's Job Description to allow electronic payments with an email approval from the Chairperson as a second

signature on the payment.

*The Spring Assembly/Convention:* will be hybrid, with the in-person location in Syracuse. We need volunteers to help with hospitality & set up/clean up. Any GRs who are willing to help, please send me an email at [chairperson@nynafg.com](mailto:chairperson@nynafg.com). The 2023 FALL Assembly will be an IN-PERSON, election assembly, which Ruth S graciously volunteered to chair. Thank you, Ruth!!!! Please volunteer to serve on the planning committee. A hybrid component for the Spring Assembly will be considered.

## WSO Road Trip! October 29, 2022

*Prepared. Punctual. Professional!!!*

I heard a local speaker say - that one of the ways she recovered was to "get in the middle of Al-Anon". I started to picture in my head what that would look like for me. For my personal recovery I envisioned meetings, talking to my sponsor, fellowship, phone calls & reading CAL.

*Two days later I found myself at the WSO Road Trip! YOU & YOUR Board Connect.* It was an 8 hour Board of Trustees meeting in Cleveland Ohio, Saturday Oct 29th, 2022. The day was filled with a fellowship icebreaker, interactive workshops, committee report presentations, Q&A's & my favorite, personal sharings. I was truly in the middle of the "How It Works" of Al-Anon.



*I learned about the 4 areas of leadership in Al-Anon:* Board of Trustees, Executive Committee, WSO Staff, & Delegates/Fellowship. As the duties & obligations of each section are clear, there are many reviews & approvals that cross over between the areas. Someone said we are in a circle, not on a ladder. I felt this to be true. I felt the strong & consistent presence of many spiritual principles including: mutual respect, balance, courtesy, kindness, accountability, responsibility, equality, abundant thinking, honesty, trust & unanimity.

## (Road Trip, Cont'd) -

*I learned that the Trustees operate with 7 - 21 members. 19 spots are trustees at large, sustaining trustees & regional trustees & can be filled by current members. 2 spots are considered lifetime for Lois & Ann (our founders). I felt the presence of Lois & Ann throughout the day. I saw the trustees working hard to be the voice of the members always using care & consideration. I heard that Trustees are just people who hide their wings...*

*We talked about the difference between a work group, a thought force, & a task force. A work group is a unit of people to meet an ongoing need, & can be*

permanent. A thought force is temporary, it is the thinkers, they brainstorm ideas. They lay the foundation for the task force, their task is not to provide answers or solutions. A task force is a temporary unit, & they are the doers. Their objective is to complete a task, to present it to the originating body to move forward.

*I learned that the answers to most Al-Anon questions have already been addressed & can be found in our policies, guidelines, service manual, steps, traditions, concepts, CAL or on the website. I just need to look for them. For me, I learn by listening & doing, which is what happened at the road trip.*

*At the end of the day - I felt more "a part of Al-Anon" than ever. The experience showed me that you are never alone in service & that service is God centered. The welcoming, loving compassion that was in the room was infectious & I hope to carry that back to my fellow Al-Anon members. ▲▲▲*

**I arrived at the door of Al-Anon joyless. ...**

The family disease of alcoholism had "hoovered" all of the joy out of my life. As I recovered, joyful experiences slowly returned. What really turbo-charged the return of joy was Al-Anon Service. I quickly learned that service work gave me more than I gave "it".

I will never forget my first NYN Spring Assembly/Convention. As a newly minted group representative (GR), the whole experience was surreal. On the drive to the conference, we needed to stop for dinner. When asked where, no one could voice a specific location. The driver joked that this outcome was only possible in a car filled

with "Al-Anoners". While paying my registration fee, the volunteer guessed that I was a new GR. How did they know? I paid in one-dollar bills. It never occurred to me that I could exchange all of those ones for larger denominations! The Assembly meeting was filled with acronyms that left me clueless. My sponsor lovingly told me their meanings & not to worry in time this would all make sense. The whole weekend was filled with joyful fellowship. I laughed more that weekend than I had in years. The "Al-Anon high" filled my world for days upon returning home. It was like walking on clouds!

In our Area, there are groups without GRs, districts without DRs, AISs without a

full panel of officers & coordinators, & the same is true for NYN. People are remaining in positions long past their end-of-term - just to keep that arm of our service structure functioning. This is not healthy for the individual as well as for Al-Anon. From my experience, staying in a service position long after my term has expired "hoovers" all of the joy that position once provided. In that void, negative emotions seep in. Service work becomes joyless WORK.

The issue of unfilled service positions pre-dates the pandemic & is a world-wide concern. The pandemic certainly accelerated this trend. It is just my

opinion, but perhaps the root cause is that service is equated with work - & we already have way too much work in our lives. What seems to have been forgotten is the JOY that serving Al-Anon brings. The joy in meeting new people. The joy in having extended fellowship time. Even the joy & laughter that occurs during business meetings.

At the 2023 Fall Assembly, NYN will elect a new panel of Officers & Coordinators. It's not too early to start

thinking which of your talents could be shared at the "Area" level. If you are not in the position to hold an Area service position, there are opportunities within your District & Group. Finally, I encourage you to think of Al-Anon service as JOY instead of work.
