Alateen service is for anyone with at least two years of consistent Al-Anon participation. Active members of Al-Anon who are also AA members may serve as an Alateen Group Sponsor, providing they fulfill the minimum requirements as an AMIAS. At all times emphasis shall be placed on the Al-Anon interpretation of the program
