Our Delegate Reports from WSO

As Delegate, it was an honor to attend and participate in the World Service Conference (WSC) which was held April 18th–21st in Virginia Beach, VA. I want to start by expressing my gratitude for all the support I received from the groups through your cards and well wishes during the World Service Conference. The days were long and packed with so much information. It was hard work, but I enjoyed taking part in doing the business of a spiritual program. When I returned home, I had fun learning how to put a slide show presentation together and giving my Delegate's Report at the Spring Assembly. That report is available on the NYN Website on the Newsflash /AWSC and Assembly Meeting Information page (Area Events). If you have any questions about my report, please contact me at delegate@nynafg.com.

One important piece of information to share with your groups is that the WSO cannot operate without our continued financial support. We do this through our group and individual voluntary contributions and by purchasing literature through the WSO directly, from our Al-Anon distribution centers (AIS offices & book depots), or at meetings. Each year the WSO spends \$331/group. In 2023, only 61% of groups contributed, and those groups sent in an average of \$196/year. Please share this information with your Group Treasurer and ask how much your group contributed last year. The appeal letter that is mailed to the group CMA's every quarter is a way for members to contribute directly to the WSO. Does your GR share the appeal letter and give your members an opportunity to contribute?

One of the more meaningful aspects of the WSC was the manner in which we conducted business and how I was able to work my program through the process. The World Service Conference is Al-Anon's largest group conscience, guided by Tradition 2, where we invite our Higher Power to guide us in decision making. We were there to consider issues and make decisions related to finances, service roles and our operations. I noticed that when the discussion was contentious, I could feel myself becoming guarded and getting pulled into selfrighteousness and closed-minded thinking. I was reminded how Tradition 6 says "lest money, property and prestige divert us from our primary spiritual aim" and I could feel it like an energy that was slowly creeping over me. My ego was showing up and I was having a hard time shaking it. I was powerless over that feeling and no matter how much I tried, I couldn't make it go away. It took the powerful, loving kindness of my fellow delegates, during a spiritual workshop, to melt it away. I was reminded that this is a WE program; I can't do it alone. I am so grateful for this opportunity to serve Al-Anon and continue my spiritual growth. Please keep coming back.

Growing Alateen Service

The AAPP (Area Alateen Process Person) and the Alateen/NYNAC Coordinator are glad to inform you that the New York North Area 2024 Online Alateen Recertification is finished. We have completed recertification of 38 Al-Anon Members Involved in Alateen Service (AMIASs) and the initial certification of two new AMIASs. We will continue to offer certification throughout the year to everyone who wishes to do this special twelfth step work to protect our Alateens. We are especially in need of more male AMIASs.

There are currently eight active Alateen groups. Four out of those eight groups have active teen attendance. The other four locations have dedicated AMIASs that are ready for participation of teens.

The next **Alateen Interest Meeting** will be on September 20, 2024 at 7:30 p.m. The first agenda item will be to provide members with information about Alateen and how to become a certified AMIAS. Interested participants need to register for this meeting on the <u>nynafg website</u> to receive the login information. AMIASs who are currently registered will be sent an email reminder.

As many of you know, the Area is still in need of an Alateen Coordinator. Here is a link to the <u>responsibilities of the position</u>. Basically, your job is to support the AAPP, the NYNAC Coordinator, the eight active groups and be a resource to the 40 certified AMIAS. Please consider working alongside the other Officers and Coordinators in our Area to continue to keep Alateen available to the teens of New York North.

All of the districts in our Area are in need of registered AMIASs. More members are also needed to step into service as substitute Alateen Group Sponsors. Alateen service is for anyone with at least two years of consistent Al-Anon participation. Active members of Al-Anon who are also AA members may serve as an Alateen Group Sponsor. The training takes a few hours and can be done virtually or in person. We are available to speak to individual Al-Anon groups and at District/AIS meetings to share about the "Joys of Service" in Alateen.

Hello fellow Al-Anon Members,

Safe travel wishes to all, and a gentle reminder to consider Public Outreach even when you are away on vacation.Consider taking some pamphlets or bookmarks and: dropping some off if you have to use a laundromat while you are away, posting some up on a bulletin board at the local market or leaving some on an information table at a church you might go to.

Regarding this month's topic of "It Works If You Work It", it seems to me that this is one of the most important themes. When I struggle in my daily life with different deadlines, situations and stressors, I become aware that it is usually because I am not "working it"-not working the program, not following the steps, not reading my literature, not talking to my sponsor and especially not making time with my Higher Power. I also see this at my District's level-we have a sad lack of service. District 8 encompasses the Albany area with 20+ meetings, but less than half of our groups have Group Representatives, and we only have three District service positions filled. Our literature tells us that Service is part of recovery-to me, "It Works If You Work It" also means doing Service work.

It Does Work If You Work It


It Works If You Work It: Benefits of Working the Al-Anon Program is a doctoral thesis that was presented to the Board of Trustees in July 2023. The research was based on the 2018 AFG Membership Survey. The findings were that "longevity in Al-Anon is a key component to better mental health." Al-Anon's "therapeutic elements" associated with positive change were: attending meetings, being spiritually motivated, working with and serving as a sponsor, and engaging in service.

I know that I have experienced this for myself. When I came into Al-Anon, life felt like one big chore to me. I had it in my mind that once I finished my "to-do" list, then I could relax, take a break and have some fun. The problem was, the "to-do" list was never-ending. Al-Anon taught me how to live in conscious presence. I still have the same to-do list and I still do the same things. I am just present while doing them, and I now enjoy life as I'm doing it. Al-Anon showed me how to live. I'm forever grateful for this program.

Our surveys show that many members find Al-Anon through the recommendations of health professionals. After members complete the surveys the results are published by the WSO. Health professionals then use the data and publish findings based on the data. These findings are confirmed by the members. Professionals then recommend Al-Anon and help carry the message. Our survey participation makes this possible.
