The plan would be to publish the "opt" in method in 3 consecutive newsletters.

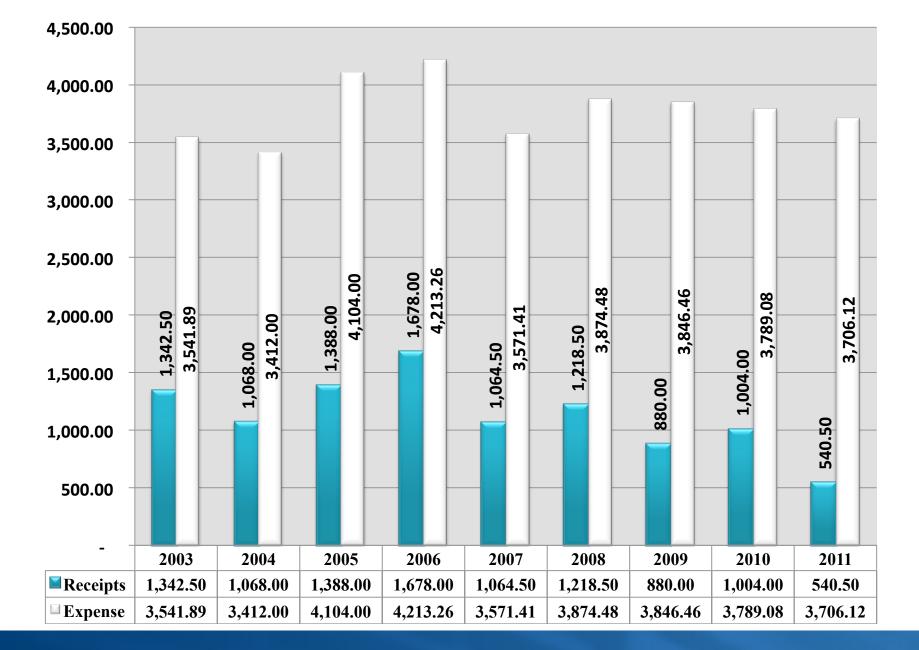
Background Information

2009

Ad-Hoc Committee was formed at the 2009 Fall AWSC meeting

- Discussion at the Spring 2010 Assembly on Pros& Cons of electronic delivery

Spring 2011

- Email Addresses added to Listserv
- April 2011: 1st Electronic version of the Northern Hi Lights sent from the Listserv & Newsletter Coordinator discontinues use of personal Email Distribution list to distribute newsletter
- Spring Assembly: Discussion continues during Newsletter & Web Coordinator reports

- Creating Email Addresses

E-buddy

- If a member does not have access to a computer or is not familiar with e-mail, another member can be asked to receive the e-mail messages, download the messages and print them.
- An "E-buddy" can also be used as a mentor to help an individual learn how to use electronic mail.

Creating an e-mail address

- The ideal is for an e-mail address being used for Al-Anon purposes to be related to Al-Anon, within the fellowship and outside the fellowship.
- When a trusted servant's position is the username, the same e-mail addresses can be used and the password changed as trusted servants practice rotation of service. Ex. nyndistrict3dr@gmail.com.
- Simplifies need to delete and create new e-mail address and distribution lists.
